

We are excited to announce that according to our first STAR benchmark assessment, over 70% of our first and second grade students scored proficient in STAR Reading and STAR Math, which means we have many students who are on grade level! The staff and I look forward to working with parents and students to continue to promote student achievement.

- Have your student work on iReady at home.
- Read AR books with your child.
- Listen to your child read at least 15 minutes each day.
