K – 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rug Time - Parents can video students retelling their favorite story that has been read to them and tell why it is their favorite book</li> <li>• Breaking News – Parents can post a video of students retelling the story while identifying each of the elements of a story</li> <li>• Element Collage - Parents can post a picture of the student's element collage. Kindergarten student's collage can be pictures representing each element.</li> </ul>
3 <sup>rd</sup> – 5 <sup>th</sup>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Editorials – The students can create a book review to recommend their favorite book to other students. Parents can take a picture of the review and post it on their social media page and tag their ELA teacher (Cocroft – White)</li> <li>• News Report – Parents can video students retelling the story identifying the story elements along the way</li> </ul>
6 <sup>th</sup> – 8 <sup>th</sup>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• PowerPoint - Students can create a PowerPoint that highlights the story elements.</li> </ul>
