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Toshiro Conrod-Summer Project for 4th Grade ELA

Students need to read a fictional book. It can be 3rd-5th grade level. After reading the book thoroughly, create a reading cube to retell/demonstrate what the book is about. Students can use a box or any object that is shaped like a box. You may use construction paper, typing paper, or notebook paper to glue on the box/cube.

Steps/procedure:

1. The cube will have six sides. Put the main characters on one side.
2. Write the setting on one side
3. Put the problem on one side.
4. Put the solution on another side.
5. Put the story's mood on one side.
6. On the last side, write the author's purpose for telling the story.

7. Draw pictures or use pictures from magazines or newspapers to illustrate the book on each side.

Have fun by making your reading cube an eye catcher! Be creative and neat!
