

READING PACKET GUIDELINES

All students must complete and submit a reading project in one of the following ways:

- Via a digital presentation using PowerPoint, Google Slide, or digital presentation format of their choice.
- Via a paper book or poster that they create at home. Students must submit pictures of their poster or pictures of each page of their book. All pictures must be taken so that all writing is legible.
- Via a video of themselves presenting on their book.
- Via a written or recorded (i.e. video) interview in which you discuss your book with a sibling or family member.

All digital presentations, pictures of projects, and videos must be sent to ablossom@sunflower.k12.ms.us and must include *all the designated criteria* outlined in the 2018-2019 Reading Fair Project.
