Accelerated Reading

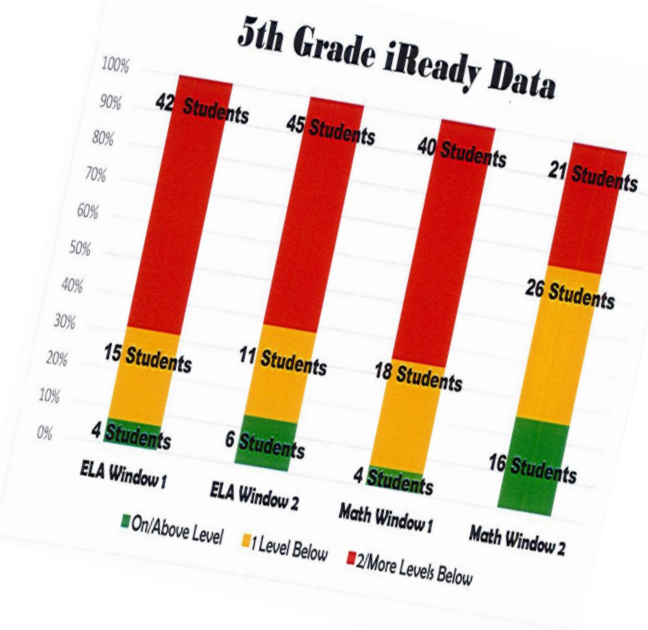
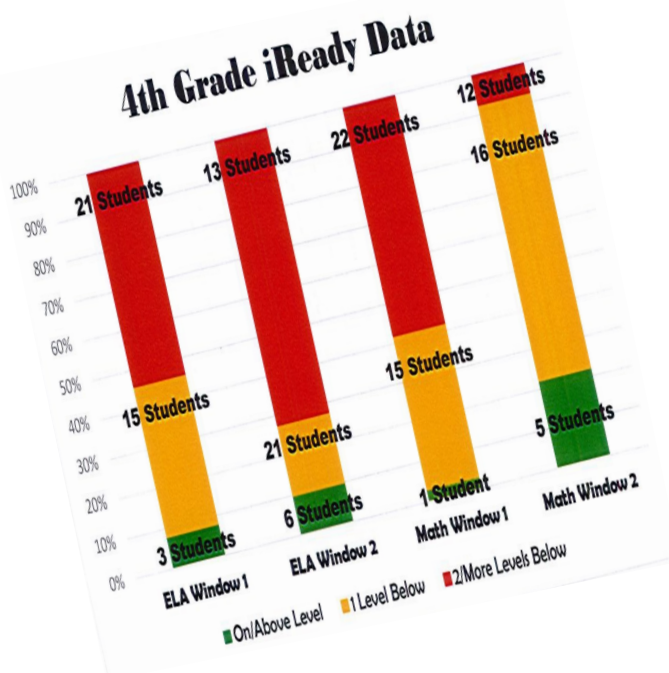
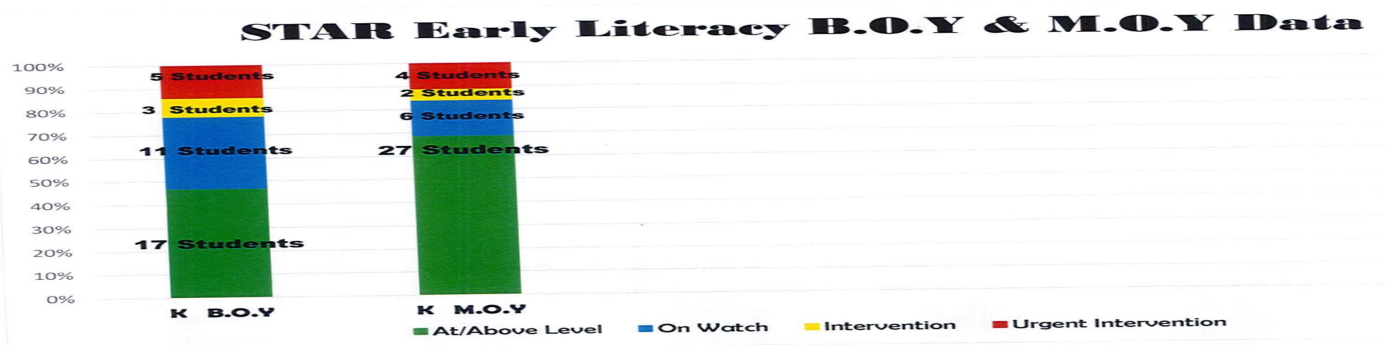
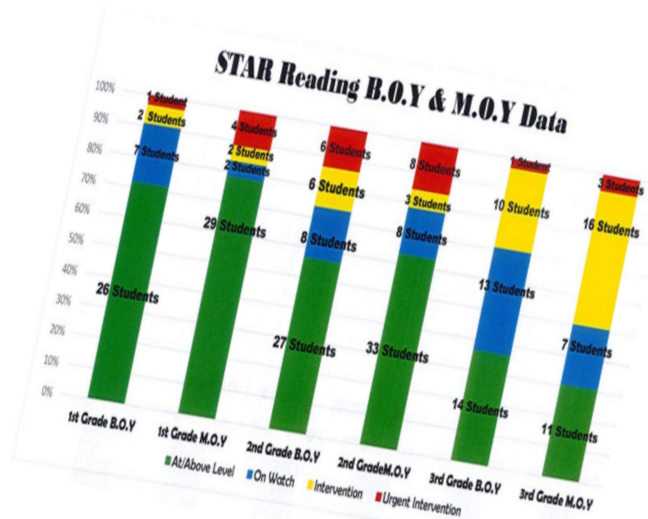
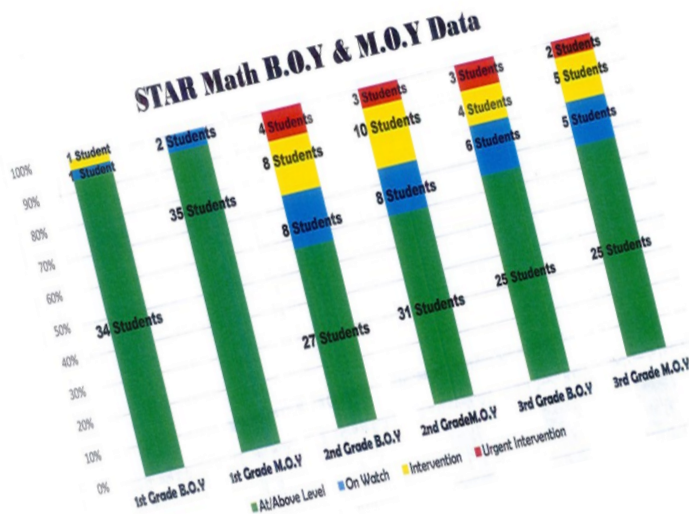
We encourage our students to read 25 minutes daily and their Accelerated Reading goal is 85%. Parent encourage your child to read daily. Thanks for your support.
