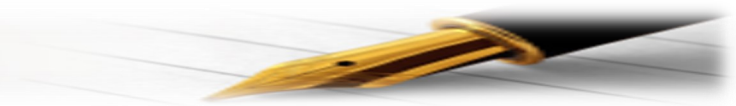

PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE



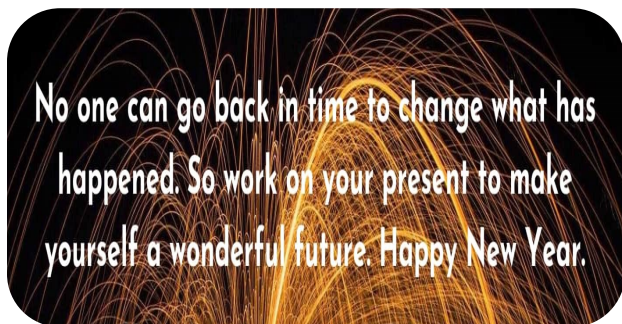
Welcome Back!!!
