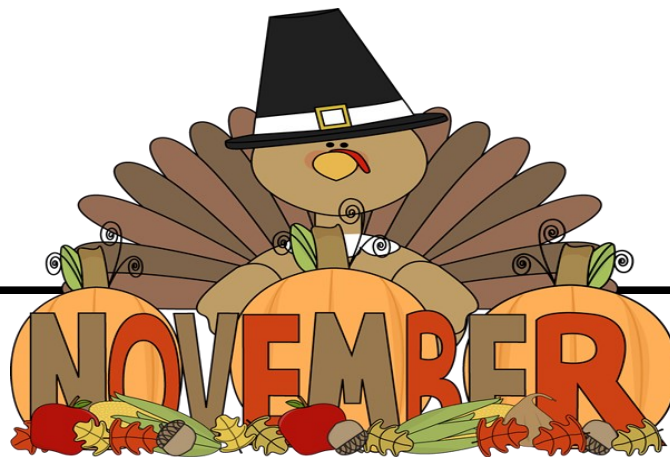
At TEEHS, juniors and seniors had a chance to visit different colleges and university in The Tiger Den.
