Homework Tips for Parents of ELLs

Homework is important for students and their academic success, but helping children with homework can be difficult — especially if you are still learning English. Here are some ways you can make homework easier for everyone — and remember that your involvement is the key to your child's success, no matter what language you are using!

Help your child get organized

Help your child pick out a special homework notebook or folder, and make sure your child has homework supplies, such as: pencils, pens, writing paper and a dictionary.

Get into a routine

Set a regular time for homework every day, and look for a homework area with good light. Help your child get into the habit of getting homework done before doing other activities

Limit distractions

Turn off the TV and video games, and restrict phone calls and texting during homework time. If your child is using the computer for homework, check in periodically to make sure he is getting homework done.


