## Minimum Course Requirements

- 4 Credits in English (English 1, 2, 3, 4)
- 4 Credits in Math (Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2 a higher level math course with Algebra 2 as a prerequisite)
- 3 Credits in Science (A physical science, Biology, Earth or Environmental)
- 3 Credits in Social Studies (Civics/Econ, US History, World History)(4 with Class of 2016)
- 2 Credits in CTE, Arts Education, or World Language
- 1 Health and PE Credit (Health and PE 1)
- 4 Credits in Subject Concentration or Career and Technical Education (CTE) Cluster, one of which must be a second year level or advanced course in the selected cluster. (Recommended)

Remaining Credits are electives of student's choice to equal the minimum of 27.

## Advanced Courses

Bartlett Yancey High School has fully implemented the standardized transcript mandated from the Department of Public Instruction. Specified courses will receive the state schedule of weighted quality points. This will benefit students that opt to enroll in Honors, Advanced Placement, and Courses that are eligible for weights. The weighted courses offered at Bartlett Yancey are listed below.

It is recommended that the scope and sequence be followed in all courses with the advanced course being taken the following semester.

The topics selected and the depth of treatment in weighted classes put high expectations on the student. The content and goals are substantially higher than those described in the North Carolina Standard Course of Study. Emphasis is on providing challenging content to academically mature students.

## NC Scholar Requirements

To be eligible for NC Academic Scholars Program, a student must meet the requirements as set by the North Carolina State Board of Education. The Requirements are as follows:

Students must have an overall un-weighted grade point average of 3.5, and complete the following credit requirements.

- 4 English Credits (English 1, 2, 3, 4)
- 4 Math Credits (Algebra 1, Algebra 2, Geometry, and a higher level math course with Algebra 2 as a prerequisite)
- 3 Science Credits (a Physics or Chemistry Course, Biology and an Earth or Environmental Science Course)
- 3 Social Studies Credits (World History, Civics/Econ, US History)
- 2 Foreign Language Credits (Must be 2 Years of same language)
- 1 Health and PE Credit (Health and PE 1)
- 4 Credits in Subject Concentration or CTE Cluster (recommended)
- 3 Credits in the Junior and/or Senior year that are advanced level courses
- 5 Elective Credits
