Here are a few important things to remember about 8th grade:

- ALL 8th Graders take 3 EOG tests:
 - Math
 - Reading
 - Science

The math EOG is all Calculator Active

Alg 1 students also take the Algebra 1 EOC

- All 8th Graders should maintain a binder and make an effort to stay organized. Demerits are given for not being prepared for class. Good training for 9th Grade!
- Lockers are optional.
- 8th Grade uses the Incentive Ticket Behavior Management Program. Students are rewarded for positive behavior with Incentive Tickets and demerits are taken for negative behaviors. Consequences of accumulated demerits are parent contact, lunch detention, after-school detention and office referrals.
- Students should try to obtain and keep Incentive Tickets. These tickets are used to "pay for" Afternoon Offs, items from the Ticket Cart, and souvenirs on Aloha Day.
- Students are allowed to bring their own technology! However, they are subject to class rules ~ devices will be confiscated and require parent pick-up from the office if used without permission or inappropriately.
- NEW POLICY! 8th Grade progress reports will not be printed unless requested by a parent or guardian. Student grades will be available for viewing online ~ you will receive more information about how to access "PAMS".
