	Students are ineligible to return to regular classes until all ISS is complete; If absent on assigned ISS day, student will report to ISS on the day he/she returns.
	Violation of ISS rules will result in additional days of ISS or OSS.
	No jackets, coats, caps, or hats will be allowed at your desk in ISS.
7.	No passes to lockers, class, labs, support groups, tutoring, or the like will be given. Do not leave your assigned seat unless permission is given. (Emergency evacuation and procedures will be followed.)
8.	Do not talk. If you have a question, raise your hand.

	Sit in the direction of your desk.
11	.If a student misbehaves in ISS, he/she may be referred to administration or assigned additional days of ISS.
