Success Seminar students will be participating in a lesson on Healthy Teen Relationships and Teen Dating Violence. After the lesson, we will be screening the Netflix Documentary Audrie and Daisy. A synopsis of the documentary is below:

In two towns on different sides of America, two teenage girls pass out while intoxicated at high school parties and, while unconscious, both are sexually assaulted by boys they call friends. In the aftermath, the girls each endure online harassment, both attempt suicide, and tragically, one dies. The film explores this new public square of shame from the perspective of the teenagers and their families -- including the boys involved in the assaults and the girls willing to speak out publicly. AUDRIE & DAISY is an urgent real-life drama that examines the ripple effects on families, friends, schools and communities when two underage young women find that sexual assault crimes against them have been caught on camera. AUDRIE & DAISY takes a hard look at America's teenagers who are coming of age in this new world of social media bullying, spun wildly out of control.
