

# April 2019 Senior Lowdown

**Seniors:** As soon as you start receiving financial aid award letters from colleges or scholarship awards please bring a copy to Mr. Brown so that your **scholarship/grant totals can be recognized on Senior Awards Night**. Please bring award info from any school that you have been awarded grants/scholarships from as we will publicize those also!

## **Senior Dates:**

May 30th- Senior Awards Night/Academic Awards at 6 PM in the Gym

June 7<sup>th</sup> - Graduation Practice 9:00 AM (this is required to walk at graduation)

June 7<sup>th</sup>- Graduation 6 PM- Must arrive by 4:30 PM in cap and gown

## **Scholarships:**

**American Legion Post 81 RCC Nursing Scholarship:** This scholarship is for students planning on attending RCC and going into the Nursing Field. Eligible applicants must plan to enroll in either the Associates Degree Nursing program, the Associate in General Education program while waiting admission to nursing, or the Associate in Arts (college transfer program) with the intention of transferring to a four year university to obtain a degree in nursing. Applicants must have a 2.0 and have financial need. There will be at least one scholarship winner from Eastern Randolph so please pick up an application in the Guidance office. Applications are due back to Mr. Brown by Friday **April 23<sup>rd</sup>**.

**American Legion Post 81 Scholarship:** this is a \$1000 scholarship to an ERHS Senior. Students must be applying for admission to a 2 or 4 year college. Students can attach resume and a letter stating need for scholarship along with intentions for your college major. A teacher or counselor recommendation is encouraged. Applications can be picked up from Mr. Brown and are due back to him by **May 1st**.

**Ramseur/ERHS Chamber of Commerce Business Scholarship:** This \$250 scholarship will go to a senior at ERHS who is planning on majoring in Business at a 2 or 4 year college. Please pick up an application from Mr. Brown in Student Services. Applications are due back to Mr. Brown by **May 1st**.

**Susan Richardson Small Health Sciences Scholarship:** This is a \$500 memorial scholarship available to any senior wanting to pursue a career in the medical field. Application materials are due to Mr. Brown by Friday **May 3<sup>rd</sup>**. A handwritten letter is required with the following information:

- \*Student's name - address - date of birth
- \*Parent(s) name - place of employment - job title
- \*Clubs student is involved with (please include any church projects)
- \*Student's favorite teacher while attending elementary school - why he/she is favorite
- \*Student's favorite subject and the reason
- \*Student's reasons for their career choice and their college/university of choice matching that career
- \*Student must tell why they feel that they should receive the \$500.00 scholarship

**Jacob Levy Memorial Scholarship:** The memorial scholarship is awarded to a graduating Eastern Randolph High School senior or seniors who have participated in JROTC for a minimum of four (4) semesters and who has been accepted by, and will be entering a college, a university, a 2+ year job training program, or the military. Applications are available in guidance and due back to Mr. Brown by **May 3rd**.

**Liberty Lions Club Scholarship:** This is a \$500 scholarship awarded to one senior from Eastern Randolph High School. Student must be living in the Liberty School District or Ramseur School district and be planning on attending a two or four year college or university. Selection is based on service to community, financial need, and academic record. Students must attach a list of service activities with description. Applications are available in student services and due to Mr. Brown by **May 3<sup>rd</sup>**.

**Sandy Waugh Bradshaw Scholarship:** This scholarship is in memory of Sandy Waugh Bradshaw who lost her life during the attack on 9/11. This is a \$1000 scholarship given to one senior at ERHS. Along with completing the application you must attach a resume and personal statement explaining any specific need for the scholarship. Applications are due to Mr. Brown by **May 3rd** and can be picked up in Student Services.

**Coleridge Lions Club** - The Lions club is giving away a \$1000 for a male and female graduating senior. You must have graduated from Coleridge Elementary. Please pick up a generic scholarship application in Student Services office. An optional resume and/or personal statement for the scholarship can be attached to the application. Applications are due to Mr. Brown by **May 3rd**.

**Liberty Rose Garden Scholarship:** This is a ERHS/PG Scholarship that is for a student taking CTE classes in the Horticulture/Agriculture Program. Applications can be picked up in Mr. Brown's office and are due back by **April 28<sup>th</sup>**.

**ABWA Scholarship:** The American Business Women's Association is awarding a \$1,000 scholarship to a female student going to a 2 or 4 year college. Student must have at least a 3.0 GPA. Applications must be completed by **May 15** at [www.sbmef.org](http://www.sbmef.org).
