

March 2019 Senior Lowdown

Scholarships:

Seniors: As soon as you start receiving financial aid award letters from colleges please bring a copy to Mr. Brown so that your scholarship/grant totals can be announced on Senior Awards Night.

Asheboro Kiwanis Club Scholarships: The Asheboro Kiwanis Club is awarding 4 \$1,500- \$2,000 scholarships to students in Randolph County. This scholarship is based on financial need but also takes into account scholarship and academic achievement and community involvement. There are no minimum requirements for this scholarship so please pick up an application in Student Services. Deadline for applications is **Wednesday March 15th, 2019** to Mr. Brown in Student Services.

Randolph County Democratic Women Scholarship: Scholarship is available to any Randolph County senior who has or will meet the following requirements: 3.0 GPA, 500-word essay, in MLA format about a significant event that has occurred in their lives and should also include their future goals. Acceptance to an accredited school of higher learning that offers an Associates or Bachelor's degrees. Student Statement of Estimated Family contribution as identified on the FAFSA letter. Your input on any special circumstances we should consider. List of awarded scholarships. Alpha Delta Kappa Scholarship: The Beta Nu chapter is giving one \$1,000 scholarship to a male or female student from Randolph County Schools who intend to major in education in college. Applications are available in Student Services and are due back to Mr. Brown by **March 20th**.

Delta Kappa Gamma Scholarship: The Alpha Upsilon and Beta Nu Chapters are giving a scholarship to a female who plans on entering the teaching profession. They are awarding one \$1500 scholarship to a female student graduating from Randolph County High Schools. Applications are accessed by Google Doc and need to be submitted by **March 15th**. See Mr. Brown to be emailed the application.

Randolph County Retired School Personnel Scholarship: The RCRSP is giving away a \$750 scholarship to a senior from a Randolph County school who will be pursuing a career in education. Applications are available from Mr. Brown and are due back to him by **April 8th**.

Tri-County Ruritan Scholarship: This is a \$600 scholarship to an ER student. Requirements are a 2-3 page essay addressing a variety of personal topics listed on the application. Pick up an application form Mr. Brown in Student Services. **Due date is March 27th to Mr. Brown.**

Randolph Telephone Scholarship: If you are a customer of Randolph Telephone you are eligible to apply for this local scholarship. This award typically is around \$1000. See Mr. Brown in Guidance for an application. Turn applications into Mr. Brown by **Thursday March 29th 2019.**

NCHSAA Endowed Fund Scholarships: The NCHSAA Endowed Fund offers several scholarships to eligible student-athletes of NCHSAA member schools. Applicants and their parents/legal custodians will have to supply their counselor with the FERPA form. Various student-athlete scholarships are available. Ferree Foundation Scholarship: This is a \$8000 scholarship given to one graduating senior at Eastern Randolph. Financial need is considered. Please go to www.ferreefoundation.org to print off your application and turn it in completed to Mr. Brown in Guidance by **April 5th**. This organization also offers loans for college and it has a place on the application for you to fill out if you are interested.

Randolph County Farm Bureau Scholarship: The Randolph County Farm Bureau Scholarship is a program designed to provide an opportunity for outstanding students to advocate agriculture, leadership and the Farm Bureau Federation policies. In recognition of the outstanding achievements of the student(s) and their continuing advocacy of agriculture, the Randolph County Farm Bureau will award a five-thousand (\$5,000) scholarship per year (up to 4 years) total to each student selected. Must have a family member that is a member of the Randolph County Farm Bureau. **Applications are due to Mr. Brown by Friday March 27th. See Mr. Brown for an application.**

Linda Petty Scholarship: The Petty Family Foundation donated \$6,000 to the Randolph Community College Foundation to be used to provide scholarships to local high school seniors who plan to enroll in Randolph Community College after graduation. A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to one graduating senior from each of Randolph County's six high schools. Scholarship students must plan to enroll in one of the following programs: Automotive Systems Technology, Collision Repair & Refinishing Technology, Welding Technology, or Computer-Integrated Machining. The application deadline is **March 29th** at 3 p.m. to the RCC Foundation. **Applications available in Student Services.**

BBB Scholarship: The award is open to any high school senior attending high schools in our service area who plans to continue his/her education. . A winner may plan to attend any accredited college, university, community college, or trade school, with either a 2-year or 4-year degree program, in a field of the student's choice. Four one-year scholarships of \$7500, \$5,000, and 2 \$2,500 each will be awarded. **Apply online at <https://www.bbb.org/greensboro/get-involved/donna-easter-student-ethics-award/> by Friday April 12th.**

Whitlow-Osborne Scholarship: This scholarship is available to high school seniors who are going to enter an Emergency Services curriculum at a community college, technical institute, or accredited trade school. This is a \$2000 scholarship. **Please pick up an application in the Guidance office. Applications are due to Mr. Brown by March 15th 2019.**
