Randolph County Farm Bureau Scholarship- is a program designed to provide an opportunity for outstanding students to advocate agriculture, leadership and the Farm Bureau Federation policies. In recognition of the outstanding achievements of the student(s) and their continuing advocacy of agriculture, the Randolph County Farm Bureau will award a five-thousand (\$5,000) scholarship per year (up to 4 years) total to each student selected. Completed applications can be mailed to: **Randolph County Farm Bureau, ATTN: Scholarship Committee, PO Box 2008, Asheboro, NC 27204** or dropped off at any of our office locations in the county by **April 1, 2020**. Mailed applications must be postmarked no later than April 1, 2020 to be considered. See Mr. Brown or Mrs. Sheridan for an application.

Randolph Communications General Scholarship: If you are a Randolph Communications customer you are eligible to apply for this national scholarship. If we have a winner from our county they will receive a \$2500 scholarship. Email Mr. Brown for an application. Applications are due to Mr. Brown by **March 30th**.

Randolph County Retired School Personnel Scholarship: The RCRSP is giving away a \$750 scholarship to a senior from a Randolph County school who will be pursuing a career in education. Email Mr. Brown for an application and submit it back by **April 17th**.

Ferree Foundation Scholarship: This is a \$8000 scholarship given to one graduating senior at Eastern Randolph. Financial need is considered. Please go to www.ferreefoundation.org to fill out the application and then email it to Mr. Brown by **April 10th**. This organization also offers loans for college and it has a place on the application for you to fill out if you are interested.

BBB Scholarship: The award is open to any high school senior attending high schools in our service area who plans to continue his/her education. A winner may plan to attend any accredited college, university, community college, or trade school, with either a 2-year or 4-year degree program, in a field of the student's choice. Four scholarships totaling \$17,500 will be awarded. **Apply online at go.bbb.org/gso-ethicsawards by April 17th.**

American Legion Post 81 RCC Nursing Scholarship: This scholarship is for students planning on attending RCC and going into the Nursing Field. Eligible applicants must plan to enroll in either the Associates Degree Nursing program, the Associate in General Education program while waiting admission to nursing, or the Associate in Arts (college transfer program) with the intention of transferring to a four year university to obtain a degree in nursing. Applicants must have a 2.0 and have financial need. There will be at least one scholarship winner from Eastern Randolph so email Mr. Brown if you are interested in this scholarship.

Ramseur/ERHS Chamber of Commerce Business Scholarship: This \$250 scholarship will go to a senior at ERHS who is planning on majoring in Business at a 2 or 4 year college. Please email Mr. Brown for an application. Applications are due back to Mr. Brown by **May 1st**.

Susan Richardson Small Health Sciences Scholarship: This is a \$500 memorial scholarship available to any senior wanting to pursue a career in the medical field. Email application materials to Mr. Brown by Friday **May 1st**. A typed letter is required with the following information:

- *Student's name - address - date of birth
- *Parent(s) name - place of employment - job title
- *Clubs student is involved with (please include any church projects)
- *Student's favorite teacher while attending elementary school - why he/she is favorite
- *Student's favorite subject and the reason
- *Student's reasons for their career choice and their college/university of choice matching that career
- *Student must tell why they feel that they should receive the \$500.00 scholarship

Jacob Levy Memorial Scholarship: The memorial scholarship is awarded to a graduating Eastern Randolph High School senior or seniors who have participated in JROTC for a minimum of four (4) semesters and who has been accepted by, and will be entering a college, a university, a 2+ year job training program, or the military. Email Mr. Brown for an application and send it back to Mr. Brown by **May 1st**.

Liberty Lions Club Scholarship: This is a \$500 scholarship awarded to one senior from Eastern Randolph High School. Student must be living in the Liberty School District or Ramseur School district and be planning on attending a two or four year college or university. Selection is based on service to community, financial need, and academic record. Students must attach a list of service activities with description. Email Mr. Brown for an application and send it back by **May 1st**.

Sandy Waugh Bradshaw Scholarship: This scholarship is in memory of Sandy Waugh Bradshaw who lost her life during the attack on 9/11. This is a \$1000 scholarship given to one senior at ERHS. Along with completing the application you must attach a resume and personal statement explaining any specific need for the scholarship. Email Mr. Brown for an application and send it back by **May 1st**.

Coleridge Lions Club - The Lions club is giving away a \$1000 for a male and female graduating senior. You must have graduated from Coleridge Elementary. Please pick up a generic scholarship application in Student Services office. An optional resume and/or personal statement for the scholarship can be attached to the application. Email Mr. Brown for an application and send it back by **May 1st**.

Howard Johnson Memorial Scholarship:
