

To access Canvas: 1) Go to the Northeastern website. 2) Click on the blue "Home Base" button. 3) Log in as you do at school. 4) Click on "Canvas" and look for your grade, team or teacher. 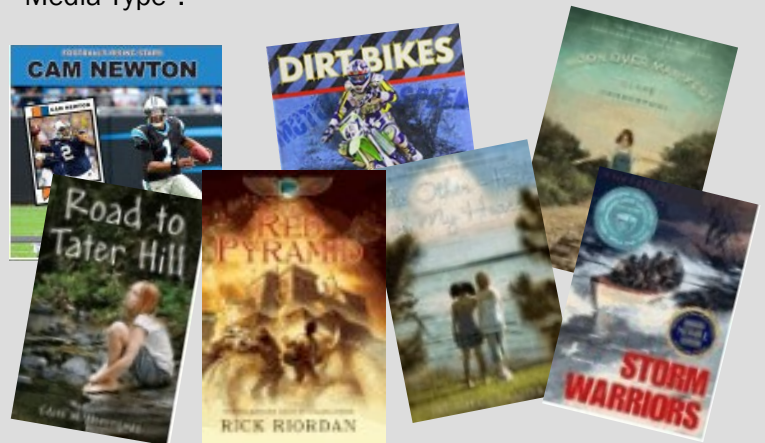

i-Ready[®] Math & Reading

Your child is already using i-Ready at school and can continue with lessons, individually chosen based on past performance, right where he/she left off last week. If your child hasn't completed the diagnostic test for reading, the assessment must be completed during the hours 8:00 am to 3:00 pm M-F. After your child has completed the diagnostic, please have him or her complete one math and one reading lesson each day. Other than the reading diagnostic, these lessons can be completed at any time. To access i-Ready go to the Northeastern website and click on the i-Ready button. Log on as usual. If you have a problem logging on e-mail your teacher through school e-mail.
