

If your child hasn't completed the diagnostic test for reading, the assessment must be completed during the hours 8:00 am to 3:00 pm M-F. After your child has completed the diagnostic, please have him or her complete one math and one reading lesson each day. Other than the reading diagnostic, these lessons can be completed at any time.
