

Senior Information 2018



- **Graduation from Randolph Community College – Wednesday, May 9th at 6:30 p.m. at Asheboro High School Gymnasium**
 - Make sure to apply for graduation through Webadvisor in Student Planning
 - All students who intend on participating should have ordered a cap and gown through RCC's bookstore – Green box on the left side labeled Herff Jones. If you missed the deadline, you must go to the Bookstore.
 - Message from Mr. Peterson in an email sent to all Seniors on **February 5, 2018**: You will pay when you pick it up from the bookstore in late April or early May. The cost is generally \$35.00. If you are borrowing a cap and gown from a previous graduate, you can order just the tassel from the bookstore. The link has other graduation items as well.
 - RCC Cap and Gown Pick-up starts **May 1st**. *On Friday, May 4th, the Bookstore will close at 2:30 p.m. as usual.
 - Please follow all directions of the college and plan to meet on time at the graduation site.
 - You must have a cap and gown to participate in the commencement ceremony.

 - **Celebration of Achievement is Thursday, May 10 at 2:30 p.m. in the CEIC.**
 - All seniors are expected to attend.
 - **You must wear your cap and gown.**
 - Caps can be decorated, but the decorations should not be higher than the button on the top of the cap.
 - **A Senior Picture will be taken at the end of the ceremony.**
 - Students will begin lining up for the ceremony at 2:00 p.m. Please be dressed and on time. Seating is limited.

 - **Graduation Practice is Wednesday, May 16, and will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. under the white tent on Front Campus behind the LRC.**
 - **All seniors must attend.**
 - All student fees must be paid in order to receive your tickets for graduation.
 - All college textbooks will need to be turned into Mr. Peterson no later than May 9, 2018. You may return your textbooks after your exams. All textbooks can be placed on the red cart outside of the office beginning on April 30, 2018

 - **Senior Picnic is Wednesday, May 16, at North Asheboro Park**
 - Please plan to attend from 12:00 p.m. – 2:00 p.m.

Tickets

- All seniors will receive **5 tickets** for graduation for seating under the tent and **4 additional tickets** for seating in the streaming locations. The graduation will be streamed in the LRC, AE018 and the BEC 102. The streaming location availability is first come, first served.

**If it rains on the day of graduation all students will receive 4 tickets for seating under the tent and 4 tickets for the streaming locations. The tent seating ticket number goes down to 4 (if it rains) because all faculty, staff, and handicapped attendees will be moved under the tent, so this will limit the seating for seniors' families.*

- **Tickets will be available in the front office Friday, May 11, 2018 upon payment of all fees.**
- If you have not paid all fees by May 11th, you will be able to pay for fees and pick up tickets at graduation practice on May 16.

Graduation Attire

- Appropriate attire is required for graduation. Please let us know if there are any concerns regarding your graduation attire.
 - Gentlemen - Shirt and tie are required. Please wear black, blue or khaki pants. No flip-flops or tennis shoes. Please wear dress shoes.
 - Ladies - All dresses must be the appropriate length. Avoid extremely high-heeled shoes. (Practice walking around in your shoes ahead of time.) No tennis shoes or flip-flops.
 - Caps may be decorated; however, decorations may not dangle from the cap or be higher than the button on top of the cap.

- **Arrive for graduation by 8:30 a.m. at RECHS with your cap and gown in hand, and go to the COMMONS.**
- Parking is limited. If you can, please try to carpool or get a family member to bring you. All students are to park behind RECHS (area closest to photography parking lot E1 and E2).

- Move quickly to allow the Junior Marshals to assist with lining up alphabetically.
