This Month in School...

Reading:Reader's Workshop

Students will be working independently, with partners, in Guided Reading and whole class to learn how to question the text, determine importance and to locate evidence in the text to support their answers. Students will make connections and read for details throughout.

Writing:Writer's Workshop

Students are currently working on writing a biography on a famous person from North Carolina. Students will be researching to find information to inform the reader about the person that they chose. Their information will be organized chronologically to describe the person's life. They will work on revising and editing their rough draft to create a final product.

Math:Measurement & Geometry

Students will begin applying concepts of measurement and finding the area and perimeter of different figures. Students will understand the area and perimeter of several shapes including complex figures. Students will also begin a geometry unit. In geometry students will identify 2D shapes, lines, angles and triangles.
