1. Reading Calendars for the month of September are due this week. Your child should be reading or being read to each night for 20 minutes. Initial their calendar each night and when they turn it in, they will get a monthly surprise. at the end of the year, those with every month completed. they will get an end of the year party.

### **Procedure Update:**

#### **Homework:**

Homework is a chance for students to practice skills that they need to work on. The teachers at the dale will strive to assign homework that addresses the needs of each child individually. When homework is assigned, it is assigned to give your child the chance to practice what they are struggling with in class. The amount of time spent on homework each night should not be more than 10 minutes per grade level.

For example:

3<sup>rd</sup> grade – 3 X 10 minute per grade level = 30 minutes of homework expected

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1<sup>st</sup> grade – 1 X 10 minute per grade level = 10 minutes of homework expected

**In addition to the assigned homework, each teacher will require students to read 20 minutes a day.** This reading can be done alone, reading to a parent, or a parent reading to them (K-1<sup>st</sup> grade). The success of a child in school increases tremendously when they develop a habit of reading each night. We hope you will support this extremely important assignment, and watch your child soar.
