1. Leadership will meet on Monday to discuss testing results from last year, school improvement plan for this year, and other miscellaneous topics.

2. During the week we will have our first Lock down drill of the year. We will have 2 during the year, and the first one will be this week. I will call the night before the drill so you are aware when it will happen. Teachers will spend time this week talking about the drill and what we will be doing to keep everyone safe.

3. Kindergarten - 3rd grade will start their beginning of the year reading assessment this week. This will help us to know where to start with small group reading instruction. Student will be pulled out of class to read to a teacher and answer a few questions about the book.

4. 3rd grade will have their BOG test on Tuesday. This is the Beginning Of Grade test for reading. Teachers will have them complete a practice test on Monday so they know and understand how to take the test on Tuesday.

5. 3 times a year, the staff selects a student to be recognized by the Board of Education for being an outstanding student. This month the staff at the dale has selected Aram Chale Castillo. He has worked extremely hard over the last 2 years at the dale learning English, and being on the A/B honor Roll. We are very proud of Aram and how far he has come over the last 2 years. He will be recognized on September 17th at the Board of Education meeting.

6. Picture envelopes will be coming home on Monday. Pictures will be on Tuesday

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September 18th. The Fall pictures are prepaid, so you will have to send in money in order to get pictures this time. There will be retakes if you are not happy with the pictures.

7. Constitution Day is on Monday the 17th. Teachers will have a lesson to teach the importance of this day to all students.

8. Every year, The Randolph County Board of Education must distribute to parents a statement about Asbestos in school buildings. ASBESTOS HAZARD EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACT (AHERA) NOTIFICATION STATEMENT

In 1988 all Randolph County Schools were inspected for Asbestos Containing Materials (ACM) according to the rules established by the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). The inspection results and the Randolph County Schools plan concerning asbestos were compiled into a Management Plan for each school. Each school's Management Plan is available to the public for inspection upon request. Interested parties should contact the Principal or the LEA designee to arrange for an inspection of the Management Plan. As required by AHERA, a periodic surveillance of all remaining asbestos material must be made every six (6) months. The most current Periodic Surveillance results are located in current volume of the AHERA Management Plan.
