

1. The Book Fair is here!

- **Open each day at 7:30**
- **Family Night on Tuesday the 25th from 5-7p**
- **Grand Breakfast will be on Thursday. To help with parking and overcrowding in the Media Center, we ask that PreK - 2nd grade grandparents come between 8-9am, while the 3rd - 5th grade grandparents come between 9-10am. If you have kids in both of those time slots, then the grandparents can get both at the same time. We just want everyone to be able to shop and eat without being rushed so that's why we hope you can come during those times.**

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2. Donuts for dads is on Tuesday for our 3rd - 5th grade students. We will have a small craft for dads to do with their child(ren), and then we will start our brief presentation at 8am. Dads are welcome to shop the Book Fair afterwards if they would like.
 - When dads show up, we will ask them to wait for the tardy bell to ring, and then we will invite them to go to the class and get their child.
 - Afterwards, they can say goodbye in the cafeteria, or they can walk them down to their classroom.
3. Interims will go home on Thursday. Please look over your child's progress and reach out to the teacher if you are concerned or have questions.
4. Our rescheduled picture day is Friday, September 28th. If you sent in money for the first time we had pictures scheduled, we have held onto the money, and will get it to Strawbridge. If you have not sent in your money for pictures, please do so by Tuesday.

Our first student led data conversation will be on November 8th. Your child's teacher will let you know the time for your classroom. Procedure Update:

Student Check-out Procedures:

- All students must be checked out through the office. Office staff will check identification as needed.
- Parent permission must be provided to the school for a student to be checked out by anyone other
- than the parent or guardian.
- If the parents are divorced or separated, their child may be released to either parent unless the
- school has been provided with a copy of a court order or a separation agreement that specifies one
- parent as primary custodian of the student or which specifically prohibits the non-custodial
- parent access to the child.
- Students will not be called to the office for checkout until the person picking up the student has
- been appropriately identified.

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- A student checkout log will be kept in the office, which includes the signature of the person
- checking out the student, the student's name, purpose of checkout, time and date.
- Parent will not be permitted in the building after 2:15 to pick up their child(ren).
