- Upon entering the building, you will be greeted by a Student Council member and told where you will be eating lunch. We ask that you stay in that area until your child comes down for lunch. If you pre-paid for lunch, then we will tell you when they are in the cafeteria and you can join them in line. If you are bringing lunch, then your child will meet you in the designated area when they come down for lunch.
- We had everyone RSVP so we could make sure we have enough seats for everyone. If you did not RSVP, please do so as soon as possible. We will have some chairs stacked on the side if you need a seat at a table. We hope we have it covered, but this maybe one of those issues that comes up. So we will have chairs there for you if needed.
- Unless the teacher has specifically asked parents back to the rooms, we ask that you please say good bye at lunch and allow the classes to get back to the room as a class without parents. We are happy to have this event, but we do need to stay on schedule and keep on teaching the rest of the day with as little disruption as possible.
