ASBESTOS HAZARD EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACT (AHERA) NOTIFICATION STATEMENT

According to the AHERA regulations any new school built after October 12, 1988 could have a statement signed by the architect, engineer or LEA Designee stating that no asbestos building material was used in constructing the school.
