

Investiture Ceremony (Capping)

This is officially the first time a senior wears his/her gown in public. This event marks the first official transfer of leadership from the Class of 2019 to the Class of 2020. Following the ceremony, seniors earning scholarships and/or awards are recognized for their accomplishments. Only seniors who have submitted their scholarship/award letters to guidance by the deadline will be recognized at capping.

Each senior is allowed to select a **WHS member of the Junior Class** to invest (or cap) him/her during this prestigious ceremony. *Seniors without a pre-selected capper will be assigned one during practice or the day of capping.*

Juniors and seniors will practice on May 21st at 2:00 pm. Seniors must bring their cap/gown for practice. Practice usually lasts less than two hours.

The evening of capping (May 21-6pm) seniors and their junior cappers should report to the cafeteria to line up. Homeroom teachers will check students for appropriate dress.

Appropriate Dress for Capping:

Ladies – dress, skirt and top, or pant suit and dress shoes

Gentleman – dress pants, button-down/collared shirt and tie, dress shoes).

*No jeans, shorts, t-shirts, tennis shoes or flip flops will be allowed.
