RE: Bring Your Own Technology Guidelines

One of the Strategic Priorities required to support the North Carolina State School Technology Plan is *Priority 2: Universal Access to Personal Teaching and Learning*. In support of *Priority 2*, the **Randolph County School System Technology Plan 2014-2016** goal was to develop a comprehensive sustainable LEA plan for universal access. The Randolph County School System established targets to meet the goal as shown in the timeline below. One of the targets is to develop guidelines for “Bring Your Own Technology” environments in schools. In an effort to put students at the center and empower them to take control of their own learning, the Randolph County School System has written **Bring Your Own Technology Guidelines** that include the provisions as written in *Section C of Board Policy 3220 (Technology in Education Program)*. Today, we ask that the Randolph County Board of Education review the ***Randolph County School System Bring Your Own Technology Guidelines Parent/Student Agreement***.
