- Applications are available beginning November 28, 2016.
- Applications are due to your school counselor by 12 noon on December 16, 2016 or must be postmarked by December 16, 2016. If you choose to mail your application, please send it to: Wilson Academy of Applied Technology, 4510 Old Stantonsburg Road, Wilson, NC 27893.
- Applications must be hand-written in black or blue ink. Please print legibly.
- The following items are needed with your completed application. Your school counselor can assist you in retrieving these items.
 - Report Cards for 7th and 8th grades
 - EOG/EOC scores for 7th grade
 - Discipline Report for 8th grade
 - Attendance Record for 8th grade
- You must also have two out of your four core teachers (Math, English, Science, or Social Studies) complete recommendation letters.
- Incomplete applications will not be reviewed by the Admissions Team.

Note:

- Students selected for interviews will be notified by letter no later than 48 hours before their interview day.
- Interviews will be held January 2-11, 2017.
- Students will be notified of acceptance to Wilson Academy of Applied Technology by January 23, 2017.
- Signed contracts need to be submitted by January 31, 2017. Signed contracts can be given to your school counselor or sent to Wilson Academy of Applied Technology, using the address above. If you receive acceptance letters from both Wilson Academy of Applied Technology and Wilson Early College Academy, **you can only sign and return one contract.**
- Accepted students are required to attend "Commitment Night" on May 4, 2017. The ceremony will be held in the Beddingfield High School Auditorium at 6:00 p.m. Students will need to arrive by 5:15 p.m. Wilson Academy of Applied Technology will be open to guests after the ceremony.
