-If the deadline for money comes and we have not raised enough money, we will extend the deadline. This would lead to the possibility that the student would not get a T Shirt for the game, therefore Mr. Doll agreed to print colored tickets to allow the student to get out of 4th Block early.

-Mr. Doll has already sent out a phone reminder about CAW

3. BUDGET

-Wilson County Schools has begun to bring back Renaissance every 9 weeks, it is possible PTO will need to assist with this endeavor

Total profit from CAW will need to be considered before deciding on gift cards for teacher birthdays. If gift cards are given, they can be presented closer to the teacher's actual birthday.
