2017-18 Goals

Setting goals is a standard practice for any organization. Alloway Township School's goals align with the district's mission statement. The goals set for the 2017-18 school year are based on qualitative and quantitative data. These goals are set in order to guide deliberate decision-making and intentional actions. On September 12th, the Goals Committee met to finalize goals for the Board and the Superintendent. On September 26, 2017, these goals were approved by the Board at the Board of Education meeting.

2017-18 Goal #1: Student Achievement

The district's mission statement describes the school as an academic institution that aims to facilitate lifelong learning. The school will not only provide students with equal opportunities to achieve individually defined excellence but will also expect that students master the skills stipulated in the grade-level math and language arts literacy standards. The mission statement further describes how the district will provide quality programs and educators who are skilled and knowledgeable about both the standards and professional best practices.

District/Board's Goal:

The Alloway Township School Board of Education will support the district's mission to promote academic growth. The Board will frame district decisions regarding programs, personnel, funding, and resources with 'promoting student achievement' as the primary consideration.

Superintendent's Goal:

The Superintendent will develop a strategy to raise the school's % of students who meet/exceed expectations on the state-mandated PARCC assessments so that the school either matches or surpasses the % of students who meet/exceed expectations at the state level.

2017-18 Goal #2: Technology

District leadership recognizes the impact of technology on both the learning process and the students' navigation through a 21st century world. Given this impact, the school's commitment to providing well-rounded academic programs includes technology infusion that transforms learning and/or prepares students for career/real-world success.

District/Board's Goal:

The Alloway Township Board of Education will advocate for technology as a conduit for learning and communicating.

Superintendent's Goal:

The Superintendent will develop a multifaceted plan to maximize the current technology inventory both to enhance/transform learning and to make communication efficient.



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2017-18 Goal #3: Strategic Plan

One of the core beliefs shared among district leadership is that the organization must define its destination and plan a cohesive strategy to intentionally arrive at that desired destination. School districts utilize the strategic planning process to deliberately outline the points of pride, hopes for the future, and an action plan to bring the hopes to fruition. Strategic planning involves all stakeholders and provides a 3-year framework for long-term goals and planning.

District/Board's Goal:

The Alloway Township School Board of Education will empower the School Improvement Team to guide the strategic planning process and will use their leadership role to support the process.

Superintendent's Goal:

The Superintendent will lead the School Improvement Team to both lay the foundation and develop a plan to lead the stakeholders in the district through the strategic plan process during the 2018-19 school year.
