According to the American Heart Association, Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA) usually strikes school-aged children without warning...and the results are usually fatal. SCA is the number one health-related cause of death in the US during a child's adolescent years. A quick and painless cardiac screening, including an electrocardiogram (ECG), significantly increases the likelihood of identifying a cardiovascular condition, which may otherwise go undetected until it's too late. Whether a student-athlete, member of the marching band, or member of the chess club, if a child has not had a cardiac evaluation, (s)he is at risk.
