The Basics:

- Registration opens on February 1, 2018 at www.raritanheadwaters.org/naturedaycamp
- Early Bird registration ends April 1, 2018
- Refund deadline is June 1, 2018
- Each day, campers should dress for outside play, bring a change of clothes (including a bathing suit), a nut-free lunch and snack, and a reusable water bottle. Bug spray and sunscreen should be applied at home, and tick checks performed at home each day.
- Camp is rain or shine! Bring a raincoat and boots on rainy days
- Once you register, you will receive an emergency contact and allergy form to complete for each camper.
- All camp staff is First Aid and CPR certified

About Fairview Farm Wildlife Preserve

Fairview Farm Wildlife Preserve is home to the Raritan Headwaters Association. A former dairy farm, the 170-acre property now serves as a living classroom. Habitat restoration projects & scientific studies are underway across the site to support native flora and fauna, including a number of threatened & endangered species.



Fairview Farm is open every day from dawn until dusk. A visit here is a unique experience. There are no picnic tables, trash cans or playgrounds. There are, however, five miles of trails through fields & woods, a small pond, and butterfly garden. Our nature classrooms are located in our 1800's era barn complex. Learning spaces also include an Exploration Room in our brick cottage. Fairview Farm is a place to enjoy all sorts of recreational pursuits — nature walks, bird watching, photography, painting en plen aire, nature-journaling, and catch and release fishing in our pond.
