



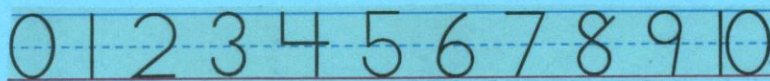
Kindergarten News



Reading

At this point, your child should be able to recognize and write all of the letters of the alphabet

(upper and lowercase), and know all corresponding sounds and some blends. Children should be able to read and write 3 letter CVC words (consonant, vowel, consonant). Students should also be able to write a simple sentence, sounding out the words on their own the best they can, and draw a picture to match their sentence...or vice versa...draw a picture and write a sentence to match. Practice independent writing every night! Continue arm-tapping our red words listed in our Word Wall Folder and practice reading skills at home.



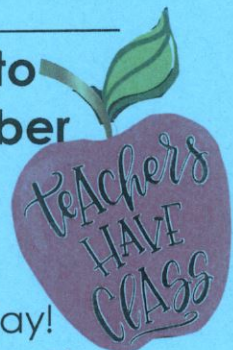
Math

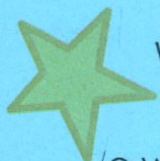
