Pitman High School Extra-Curricular Contract 2017/18

Participation in extra-curricular activities at Pitman High School is based upon a student's ability to contribute to his/her overall experience in a positive and productive manner. This ongoing tradition is achieved through interaction with others, development of skills, and the aspiration to contribute to an organization on a variety of scholastic levels.

All procedures stated below are in effect for students during any season/activity period in which they participate.

I. **DISCIPLINE/SUSPENSION (Internal or External):** Procedures related to suspension during any season/activity.

First Offense

- School discipline procedure as stated by Pitman High School.
- Unable to participate in any school activity for the duration of the suspension (including last day of suspension).

Second Offense

- School discipline procedure as stated by Pitman High School.
- Removal from activity for remainder of the season/activity (one marking period for extracurricular activities).

*Lateness to school, on day of activity, may result in student missing activity bus (based upon departure time). No student is permitted to participate in an activity if they are not transported via school transportation (i.e. after school events-sports).

II. **ALCOHOL, TOBACCO and/or CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE:** Procedures related to rules and/or policies pertaining to the use or possession of tobacco, alcohol and/or other controlled dangerous substance.

First Offense

- School discipline procedure as stated by Pitman High School.

Second Offense

- School discipline procedure as stated by Pitman High School.
- Removal from activity for remainder of the season/activity (one marking period for extracurricular activities).

III. **ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS:** Any student who fails 2 or more subjects, in marking periods 1-3 will become ineligible to participate for the following marking period within the current school year. Reinstatement may occur when grades are reevaluated at the end of the following marking period.

- Students who withdraw from a class with a failing grade are regarded in the same manner as stated above
- Students with an incomplete may not participate until all work has been finished (maximum 10 days for completion).

IV. **ATTENDANCE (Loss of credit):** Failure to maintain Pitman High School attendance standards (17 or more absences).

**Removal from all activities for the remainder of the school year. Credit completion will take place following the conclusion of the school year.

V. **LATENESS:** Any student who arrives late to school four (4) or more times will be removed immediately from all sports, clubs, and/or activities until all lates are made up (total must be at zero) prior to resuming any activity (4 lates = 4 days of detention). Students must arrive to school by 8:30 AM and attend a full day of school in order to participate in an extra-curricular activity (Friday or a Saturday game).

VI. **INAPPROPRIATE CONDUCT:** Activities that are deemed inappropriate/illegal (printed materials, Internet websites, photos, language, etc.)

- School discipline procedure as stated by Pitman High School
- Removal from activity for remainder of the season/activity (one marking period for extra-curricular activities)

If for any reason I am in violation of the above stated procedures, I accept that I will be required to complete the interventions, as required on the part of contract, in order to return to the above activity, for the remainder of the season/event.
