High School Option Program for Enrichment

Pitman High School is partnering with Rowan College at Gloucester County (RCGC) to offer Senior students enrichment courses. The courses do not replace Pitman High School Graduation requirements, but are offered as enhancement classes that are easily transferred to higher education institutions at a significantly discounted rate.

1. What type of courses can I enroll in?	Pitman High School students are encouraged to take courses that satisfy General Education electives at RCGC. These classes are easily transferrable to other institutions of higher education.
2. How do I register for the High School Option Program?	Students become officially registered after submitting the "High School Options Participation Form" to RCGC (See Attached).
3. Are there discounts offered to High School students?	The RCGC High School Option courses are offered at a <b>65% discount</b> on tuition and per-credit fees (Textbook fees are not included).
4. What is required of the Pitman High School student?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• High School Options Participation Form along with a \$20 lifetime non-refundable application fee;</li><li>• Qualifying RCGC Accuplacer Test score (free of charge) <b>OR</b> SAT score of 500 or higher in Math and/or Critical Reading <b>OR</b> PSAT score of 50 or higher in Math and/or Critical Reading.</li></ul>

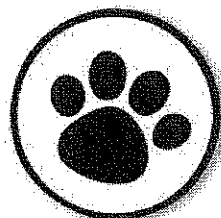
