

Criteria for Advanced Placement Selection in School #3

Selection for Advanced placement is calculated by using multiple measures. For instructional purposes Language Arts and Science are handled during the Enrichment Courses. Language Arts meets during second marking period and Science meets during third marking period. Math is a leveled class. The high school Spanish course is offered only to 8th grade selected students.

Language Arts – Reading

1. Grade Point Average in Reading

Language Arts – Writing

1. Grade Point Average in Writing
2. NJ ASK Scores
3. Holistic writing score average
4. Teacher rating scale
5. End of year test or MAP testing scores

Math

1. Grade Point Average in Math
2. Algebra prognosis test (for 7th to 8th) or end of the year test
3. NJ ASK Scores
4. Benchmarking or MAP testing scores
5. Teacher Rating Scale

Science

1. Grade point average
2. Recent NJ ASK Science scores
3. End of year test
4. Teacher Rating Scale

Spanish-8th Grade only

1. Grade point average
