Dear Parents/Guardians.

We are monitoring any flu activity closely and at present have no reason to suspect swine flu in this region. The school is thoroughly cleaned and sanitized every night with a strong germicide that is used to kill the MRSA bacteria in hospitals. We have hand sanitizers for student use, as well as sinks with soap dispensers in every classroom and restroom.
