

## DEATH VALLEY NATIONAL PARK YOUTH CONSERVATION CORPS

Death Valley National Park will sponsor a Youth Conservation Corps program for an eight week period this summer. All youths between the ages of 15 and 18 years of age are encouraged to apply. Applicants must not reach their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday during the program.

Dates of the Program: June 17, 2013 through August 10, 2013

Duty Station: Furnace Creek/Cow Creek, Death Valley, CA

Hours of Work: Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.

Salary: California Minimum Wage, \$8.00 per hour

**Description of Work:** Work will be labor intensive and performed throughout

the Park. Proposed work projects include: trail maintenance, campground rehabilitation,

fence repair, spring resource habitat improvement and resource restoration projects such as maintenance of historic aquaduct. Some

overnight camping may be required.

Crew members must be able to work the entire eight-week season in order to apply. Vacations should be scheduled around this period. This is a non-residential program, housing is not available. Transportation to the duty station will be the responsibility of the enrollee; however, carpooling is usually available from Pahrump and Beatty. If you are interested in participating in the program, complete the attached application and return postmarked NO LATER THAN April 26, 2013, to: Death Valley National Park, Attn: Human Resources, P.O. Box 579, Death Valley, CA 92328-0579 *OR* hand carry to our visitor center in Furnace Creek. Selections will be made by random drawing. Participants and alternates will be notified by May 13, 2013.
