Superintendent's Highlights

Managed Instruction: Monthly Administrative Team meetings have been held to facilitate communication, professional development and supervisor training. Teachers from the Southern Nevada Regional Professional Development Program (RPDP) and Teachers on Special Assignment (TOSA) help provide a multitude of Professional Development for school level staff on a weekly basis along with five full days of in-services throughout the school year. They also provide courses specific to the needs of our schools and communities.

School Innovation: Measures of Academic Progress (MAP)/Northwest Evaluation Association (NWEA) testing (<http://www.nwea.org/>) will be used three times by the end of this school year (Pahrump Valley High School will use it twice). Adobe Connect is being used for Instructional Consultation (IC) training and other meetings by the Department of Student Achievement. TOSAs are supporting cross-age tutoring programs throughout our elementary schools.

Principal Priorities: Southern Nevada RPDP Administrative trainers have assisted administrators with teacher classroom observations. Many new software and newly incorporated program trainings have occurred as well as management training to assist principals with management skills and Special Education Protocols and Procedures.

Instructional Differentiation: Many different strategies are being used in schools throughout our district with training sessions being conducted by a nationally certified Pearson trainer. Criterion Reference Testing and High School Proficiency Exams (HSPE) data is being provided for administrators to focus on priorities and target weaknesses. New English Language Learner (ELL) standards have also been implemented.

Educator Accountability: Many different trainings and workshops have been implemented throughout the year. State attendance audits have occurred at three schools and a state audit was conducted at Pathways Middle School and High School. A curriculum audit was conducted for the district at Amargosa Elementary/Middle School. Nye County School District (NCS) Policy and Regulations have been reviewed this year along with building administrator awareness of them.

Goals and Objectives

One of the goals of Nye County School District is to show improvement in both student achievement and proficiency levels. Another is to sustain practices within Nye County School District to increase the graduation rate and decrease the dropout rate. To maintain safe learning and working environments for all students and staff is yet another goal of Nye County School District. All goals mentioned above have been written into our District Improvement Plan.

An objective of our district is to utilize educational technology and parent involvement in pursuit of these goals. Implementation of administrative and school staff trainings are another way our district will fulfill goals. Analyzing student test scores and utilizing data will also help the district achieve goals.

District Communication Efforts

Nye County School District utilizes several meaningful ways to communicate with parents, families and our communities. We redesigned our website this year to be more user friendly and added additional communication areas such as: Press Releases, News, the Superintendent's weekly Monday Minutes and email links to district level as well as school level staff. The Nye County School District's Parent Involvement & Engagement website was also implemented this year and is maintained by our parent liaison. Building support from local media for distribution of news, events and announcements is ongoing. One of our local papers worked with us to create a "Campus Corner" for our schools to publish news, events and announcements. A local radio station willingly announces events for our district. The development of a Facebook page is also being looked at as a possibility of increasing communication.

A parent kiosk was created in both the Southern and Northern District Offices to provide parents with an additional option for obtaining information including use of a computer to obtain their child's academic and attendance information. A three week progress report schedule was created district wide for schools to send student reports home on a regular basis. Parent newsletters are sent home on a monthly or quarterly basis. Parent Involvement activities have been implemented at many of our schools including Math Night, Family Story Teller Training, as well as Title I, Gear-up and Migrant meetings to mention a few.

Blackboard Connect is an automated phone and email system which is used regularly to communicate information about students and events occurring at our schools. This system is also used to inform parents of emergency situations and unforeseen temporary school closures.
