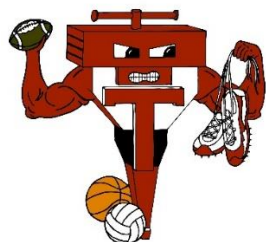
## 2018-2019 SUPPLY LIST

To do their best work, **all** students must have necessary materials. Please have your child bring these materials on the first day of school and each day regularly to class. **THIS INCLUDES THEIR COMMUNICATOR FOLDERS.** Students are **EXPECTED** to come to class prepared. Valuable class time is wasted if they are not prepared to do their work. We appreciate your cooperation and we know that together – parents, teachers and school staff – will help your child have a happy and well-rounded education.

**All students need: a sturdy backpack with their name on it; non-marking soled athletic shoes for P.E. class; and headphones to be used with their individual Chromebooks during the school day.** No earbuds, please!
