### ***Goals and Objectives***

#### **Goal 1**

Teachers will increase student proficiency in math as measured by state, district, and school assessments.

#### **Objective(s):**

One hundred percent of students will take the NWEA math test in fall 2012, January and spring 2013 and at least 80 % of them will meet or exceed the projected RIT scores.

#### **Goal 2**

Teachers will increase student proficiency in non-fiction reading comprehension as measured by state, district, and school assessments.

#### **Objective(s):**

One hundred percent of students will take the NWEA Reading test in fall 2012, January 2013 and spring 2013 and at least 80 % of them will meet or exceed the projected RIT scores.
