The Eastern Nevada Section of Society for Mining, Metallurgy and Exploration (ENSME) has established a scholarship program to help provide funding for students to continue their education and training at Colleges, Universities, Trade Schools or Vocational Schools.

Scholarship Funding will be generated through

- ENSME monthly meetings
- ENSME sponsored events such as BBQs, annual ENSME Golf Tournament and/or other fund raising events
- Silent auctions of donated items from Vendors and ENSME District Mining Companies
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- Supplemental funding from the National Section of SME, if available.

Scholarship Eligibility Criteria

- Local High School Seniors and College Students within ENSME District
 - Including Nye, Lincoln and White Pine counties
- Summer Intern of RNMC or other mining operations within ENSME District
- Applicant must be enrolled in a post high school education institution (Please attach proof of enrollment)
Application criteria:
 - Minimum GPA of 2.5
 - Cover Letter and Resume (college students only)
 - Letter of Recommendation from Counselor or College Professor
- Provide Official High School or College Transcripts
- Applicant must fill out the ENSME Scholarship Application
- Write a short essay one to two pages double spaced on mining industry topic related to Mining, Metallurgy or Exploration – “What does it mean to you?”
- Application and essay must be submitted to the ENSME Scholarship Committee by January 31, 2018

Scholarship Award

- \$1,000 Scholarship for a Trade or Vocational School
- \$1,000 Scholarship available to Children of ENSME Employees
- \$1,000 Scholarship for Mining related fields of Study
- Scholarships will be awarded in increments of \$500 per semester
- Scholarship awards will be direct deposit towards tuition fees
- Total number of Scholarships will be determined based on available funding
