REGENTS EXAMINATIONS IN ENGLISH, MATH, SCIENCE, U.S. HISTORY, AND GLOBAL STUDIES: Students who are <u>not</u> enrolled in Summer School courses but have failed any of these exams, or would like to re-take an exam, must register no later than Thursday, July 14th. The exams will be held at the High School on August 17 and 18. An exam schedule is enclosed for your reference. Students are responsible for knowing the time and date for their exam and coming prepared. Regents Schedules can be obtained online

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation is not available for Summer School.

SUMMER SCHOOL GRADES

All grades will be mailed home by the end of August.

Students attending Summer School are reminded to submit self-addressed envelope to their teachers so that their final grades can be mailed to them as soon as they are available.

SUMMER SCHOOL REGULATIONS

- A student will be dropped after three absences and every two lates count as one absence. This policy will be strictly adhered to during Summer School.
- Any student who has violated the discipline code, and has been reviewed by the subject teacher, guidance counselor, guidance chairperson, and the high school administration and found to be a chronic behavior problem, will not be allowed to attend Summer School. This includes any student who has interfered with the educational environment of their fellow students.
- 3) Students in grades 9 11 who have violated the attendance policy and received an NC will not be able to attend.
- 4) Any student who has a final average below 55 will not be allowed to attend Summer School.
- 5) All students are expected to abide by the district discipline code.
- 6) Private School parents must register their students in person with a copy of their utility bill, license, letter from their school, and their student ID number.
