WAJ will follow NYSED guidelines for our Pre-K program.

The Pre-K program is a pilot full day program that will begin on September 11, 2017 and end on May 31, 2018 and is offered at no cost to residents of the Windham-Ashland-Jewett School District.

The class is taught by a certified elementary teacher and a teaching assistant.

Transportation is provided.

Enrollment is open to all resident students who will turn 4 years old by December 31, 2017.

- Self care skills
- Music, art and enrichment
