

Spanish III: Summer Assignment 2019

Purpose: In order to keep your skills / vocabulary fresh throughout the summer and to make your transition into Spanish III smooth, the following summer assignment needs to be completed and turned in by the first week of school. Assignment 1: Writing

Write **4 journal entries** in Spanish based on the journal topics below. Each entry must be completely in Spanish, with 7-10 well-developed sentences. Choices for topics are below. You may use your own journal or the journal entry sheet provided.

1. Tell me about your favorite summer memory (does not have to be this summer)
2. Do you have a favorite summer tradition? What is it?
3. What did you do on the first day of summer vacation?
4. How do you feel as summer comes to an end?
5. What are your favorite summer activities and why?
6. Did you spend time with special people?
7. Did you take a trip?
8. Rainy summer days – What did you do?
9. Your ideal summer: what would you want to do?
10. Write a poem celebrating summer (75 word minimum)
11. What are the key ingredients to a memorable summer?
12. How do you prepare to return to school?
13. What are some of the best summer activities where you live?
14. Did you work? Tell me about your job.

Assignment 2: Listening

You should try to listen to as much language as possible in order to keep the vocabulary flowing. Keep a log of what you listen to and what it was about. Listen to a total of *at least 4 hours* of Spanish (if interest to you AND school appropriate). What should you listen to? Here are some ideas:

1. A movie (You may change the language settings if it's a movie you have seen / know well)
2. A podcast
3. Music – Pandora, Spotify, etc.
4. A newscast (originally in Spanish)
5. A cooking show
6. Cartoons in Spanish
7. Have a conversation with native speakers! – This is one of the BEST ways to practice the language!!!!
