- 3. What did you do on the first day of summer vacation?
- 4. How do you feel as summer comes to an end?

- 7. Did you take a trip?
- 8. Rainy summer days What did you do?
- 9. Your ideal summer: what would you want to do?
- 10. Write a poem celebrating summer (75 word minimum)
- 11. What are the key ingredients to a memorable summer?
- 12. How do you prepare to return to school?
- 13. What are some of the best summer activities where you live?
- 14. Did you work? Tell me about your job.

Assignment 2: Listening
