Again this year there are two different types of grants available to help meet the needs of teachers in the classroom. Each applicant may only participate in one grant request.

The first grant that is available is a mega grant. A mega grant is to be used for a single project or item that will enrich the educational opportunities for students at KHS.

The second grant that is available is a mini grant. The mini grant is to be used for one or more smaller projects that may or may not be related to each other. The upper limit for a mini grant is \$500.00. We hope that the mini grant will make it easier for everyone to find something they can request.

Please provide information about your request using the attached form. We want to know how it is creative and innovative, how it will enrich education at KHS, how many students will benefit and how, and what else makes the project special for KHS.

The deadline for turning in the application is Friday, September 11<sup>th</sup>. Turn in your completed application to your principal or superintendent on or before the deadline. We ask that they review the applications before giving them to KHAEF to make sure what is requested is not something that the school can fund. Our goal is to provide extra things the school cannot provide to enrich the learning opportunities at KHS.

The grant process is why the foundation board members do what we do. We look forward to putting the funds raised during the year into the school system to assist teachers in providing the best educational opportunities for KHS students. Contact any KHAEF member if you have questions.
