This scholarship was established in the spring of 1991 to provide financial assistance to worthy high school graduates who wish to continue their formal education. The award is to provide recognition for excellence in scholarship and citizenship. The recipients must have a realistic educational goal. Applicants must be in the top one-half of their graduating class. Financial need will be considered in the selection of recipients.

This scholarship is given to outstanding young men and women who have excelled in school. The application review, student interviews, final selection and award of this scholarship is administered by Astoria High School Scholarships, Inc.

The ILWU scholarship program was established through the generosity of the International Longshoremen's and Warehousemen's Union Local #50. The geographical area for awarding this scholarship will include the Port of Astoria District. The recipient must live within this district and attend a high school in Clatsop County.

Scholarship Recipient Selection Criteria:

1. Must be a senior in the top one-half of his or her graduating class.
2. Must have specific plans for education beyond high school consistent with educational goals.
3. Must plan to attend an accredited or licensed post-high school educational/vocational institution
4. Must be willing to be interviewed by the selection committee upon request.
5. Must have exemplified good citizenship.
6. Must have an educational belief and philosophy compatible with the International Longshoremen's and Warehousemen's Union.

Selection Procedure:

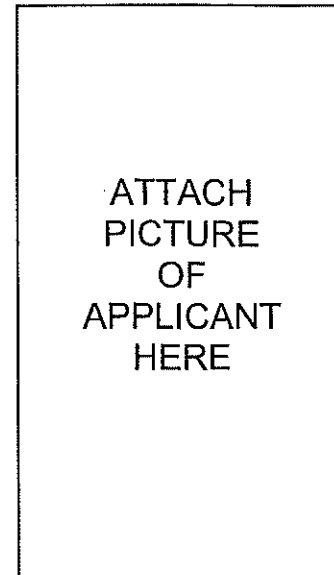
