However, this scholarship is also open to other vocational studies.

The scholarship will be offered to a graduating senior from Astoria, Ilwaco, Naselle, Jewell, Knappa, Seaside, or Warrenton High School. 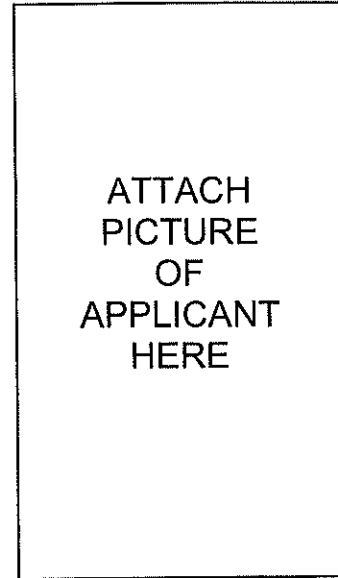
