The following specific rules are mandatory for all students *participating* in Seaside School District Interscholastic Athletic/Activity Programs. The *student participant* and *parent/guardian* must sign this form before they can turn out for the sport/activity.

### **Parent (or) Guardian Permit:**

I want my student to have the privilege of participating in competitive school athletics/activities and has my permission to compete in all sports/activities approved by the Board of Education of the local School District and to travel with the coach on any regularly scheduled trips.

### **Consent to Treat:**

I authorize the supervising coach, school employee or designee at the time of any accident or illness to consent to any medical or surgical treatment of the above student if the parent/guardian cannot be reasonably located.

### **Physical:**

The student athlete will have a physical form on file. All athletes are required to have a physical within two years of the sports completion date. Also, all transfer students, plus those students who are returning from serious injury or illness must have a recent physical on file. *This is not applicable to student's in non-athletic extra curricular activities.*

## **Training Rules:**

### **I. Substance Abuse Policy**

#### **A. Definition**

1. Any activity student participant who is found using, under the influence, in possession of any alcohol, illegal/unauthorized drugs, drug paraphernalia, look alike drugs or tobacco is in violation and subject to Seaside School District Athletics Handbook and/or Substance Abuse Policy Procedure.

#### **B. Procedure**

1. Any student participant who violate the policy in any form will receive an activity suspension as outlined in the Seaside School District Athletics Handbook, including all school sponsored activities, athletics, and extra-curricular activities.
2. The coach/advisor will notify the parents and Athletic Director or Principal immediately of said suspension. The coach/advisor will also tell the student participant and their parent/guardian of the options available.
3. Within the suspension period the student participant has one of three options:
  - a. Student participant can agree to turn in their gear.
  - b. For the first offense, the student participant may be reinstated on the team under conditions outlined in the Seaside School District Athletics Handbook.
  - c. Second time offenders will be referred to the Activity Council and they may lose eligibility for one calendar year.

**II Academics:** To be academically eligible, the student participant must have passed FOUR classes the previous semester and be passing FOUR classes during the term of competition. The student participant must be on track to graduate in four years beginning with their ninth grade year.

**III Attendance:** The student participant will maintain regular attendance in all classes. The only exception to this rule is a pre-arranged absence with the head coach. The penalty for not maintaining regular attendance will be suspension of participation – either for games or practices.

**IV Conduct:** Any action taken by a student participant, which is detrimental to the team’s morale and success, will be considered a violation. Also, any degrading or demeaning actions taken by members of any team may be subject to disciplinary actions by the school or coach.

**V Dates:** Training rules are in effect from the date signed until the awards ceremony of the sport in which the athlete participates.
