- Colleges provide preparation course work
- SCDE pays for tuition and textbooks
- All stakeholders share in the success

- Full-time employees; public/charter/SOPs
- Instructional and non-instructional staff
- Priority groups:
  - Teacher Assistants/Paras
  - General Ed Teachers (career changers)
  - Long-term/Permanent Subs
  - Reduction-in-Force Teachers
  - Office/other non-instructional staff




### **How CREATE Works**

- Submit application online or by email/fax
- Gather/submit additional documents (varies)
- Sign & submit Scholarship Loan Agreement
- Commit to returning 3 years of service to SC
- Take up to 3 courses per semester/summer
- Full tuition paid + \$150/course for textbooks
- Funds channeled through 14 SC colleges


# **Important Policies**

- CREATE funds may not be used for personal professional development, such as pursuit of a master's degree or educator license renewal.
- Withdrawal from scholarship courses or unsatisfactory grades which cause CREATE to forfeit funds will result in disqualification and reimbursement to SCDE for funds received; Recipients must replace the course with personal funds in order to be reinstated in good standing.
- Program completers must return 3 years of service to the State in their new licensure area.



# 1,025 Program Completers


14-Year Total, 2003-2017
